# The Challenge: Greater scalability, reliability, and performance needed for hosted data

When the ASO approached IT Weapons, they were grappling with major challenges in their strategic IT roadmap:

- Migrating from the ASO's legacy IT setup to a newer, scalable IT infrastructure to enable users with better productivity
- Amalgamating the ASO, AS Toronto, AS Canada branches into a unified Microsoft 365 tenant to enable central management of licenses, policies and standards
- Bringing in multiple regional branches into the Microsoft 365 suite

As the regional branches had their internal IT teams working on different initiatives, bringing the right team together and communicating the unified approach was important. These complexities led to ASO exploring a strategic IT partner and subsequently signing a deal with IT Weapons.

## The Solution: A 360° revamp of the IT infrastructure

Alzheimer Society of Ontario entered into a managed IT services agreement with IT Weapons which included IT solutions and services like:

- Microsoft 365 tenant migration
- Network refreshes
- SaaS data backups and protection
- Managed network devices
- Microsoft 365 tenant management and protection
- Hosted virtual machines

## The Implementation: Meticulous approach, lightning speed

- IT Weapons first set up a unified Microsoft 365 tenant with ASO being the parent organization.
- The experts at IT Weapons then worked with a few regional branches at a time. This involved assessing their current email and productivity solutions and taking necessary steps to migrate them to Microsoft 365. Many of these projects were completed in a matter of weeks.
- As the regional branches had a wide range of users, IT Weapons set up a phased approach to move users into Microsoft 365 to give them a seamless and familiar user experience.
- Through the journey, IT Weapons identified, assessed and provided solutions for other parts of ASO's infrastructure including backups for Microsoft 365 through SaaS protection as well as networking services.
